JUMP, Jack's Urban Meeting Place, is a nonprofit, interactive creative center and community gathering place. It's a place for everyone to discover new possibilities and explore their potential. We host non-profits, community events, artist residencies, free public festivals, and work with volunteers to create spaces and experiences that inspire and delight. There are many ways to give back to the community and the *MAKE Studio Community Project Program* is your chance to show the world what you are passionate about!

The MAKE Studio Community Project Program is an opportunity for anyone to become a volunteer and propose a community facing project utilizing JUMP spaces and equipment.

Projects must have a community engagement or educational component, like a workshop, class, lecture, 'how-to' video series, collaboration with another non-profit, or a contribution to an open source resource like Creative Commons.

We're looking for volunteers who will benefit from the temporary use of a space, equipment, or support at JUMP and are committed to sharing their talents to inspire and cultivate the potential in others.

Volunteers in the program are also expected to participate in 'normal' MAKE Studio activities, such as helping facilitate JUMP Experiences, assist with organizing spaces before and after events, and collaborating with JUMP Team members.

Community Projects are selected by the JUMP Team Selection Committee based on

- Statement of applicant's goals
- Community impact or contribution
- Commitment and self-motivation
- Timeline & logistic awareness and management
- Willingness to participate in additional JUMP activities and events

Applications should be submitted at least 30 days prior to the requested project time period.

All projects are subject to the availability of schedules, equipment, activities, and JUMP Team support. Timelines will depend on the project and may be as short as one activity or extend to multiple months. JUMP reserves the right to suspend or terminate its support of any or all projects at any time, and JUMP shall retain the right to use any project created under the Community Project Program.

NOTE: If individual or organization requests space for a community program or event (or if they are charging a fee to attendees) they should fill out a *Rental Application (link)*, not a *Volunteer Project Application*.
